### Julius Brite Dies After Heart Attack

Julius Brite, 71, prominent Adams county farmer of west of Decatur, died unexpectedly at 8 o'clock this morning at the Adams county memorial hospital, where he had been admitted an hour earlier. He suffered a heart attack Thursday evening and was taken to the hospital when his condition became worse

A lifelong resident of Adams county, he was born here July 19, 1889, the only child of John and Margaret Koenig-Brite. He was married to Miss Gertrude Geels in St. Mary's Catholic church Sept. 23, 1914.

Mr. Brite was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Holy Name society, Third Order of St. Francis, and the Moose and Eagles lodges.

He is survived by his wife; three sons, John and Roman Brite of Decatur, and Aloysius Brite of Indianapolis; four daughters, Mrs. Glen (Frances) Griffiths, and Mrs. Reinhard (Mariann) Selking of Decatur, Mrs. Charles (Justine) Walter of Fort Wayne, and Sr. M. Regina C.S.A. (Margaret), of St. Agnes hospital, Fond Du Lac, Mic.; 24 grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9:15 a.m. Monday at St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Gillig & Doan funeral home after 2 p.m. Saturday until time of the services. The Third Order of St. Frances will recite the rosary at 7:30 p.m. Sunday and the Holy Name society at 8 p.m.
