### **Clayson Carroll dies at hospital**

Clayson J. Carroll,, 83, of Decatur route 4, for many years a Decatur businessman, died at 7:10 p.m. Saturday at the Adams county memorial hospital, where he had been a patient for the past two months.

Mr. Carroll and his father, E.L. Carroll, operated the Carroll Coal & Feed Supply in Decatur from 1910 until 1940. He was employed as a salesman for the Winner House in Berne from 1944 until he retired in 1959.

Born in Huntsville, O., Aug. 26, 1888, he was a son of E.L. and Anna O'Shaughnessey-Carroll. He was first married Sept. 17, 1915 to Leah Miller, who preceded him in death April 9, 1960. He was married in 1966 to Effie Corbett, who survives.

Mr. Carroll was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Holy Name society, and the Knights of Columbus, of which he was a past grand Knight.

Surviving are the wife; one son, Dr. John C. Carroll of Decatur route 5, Decatur physician; one daughter, Mrs. Robert (Marjorie) McKean of Berne route 1; six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. A sister, Blanche, is deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Tuesday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Zwick funeral home after 2 p.m. today until time of the services. The Holy name society will recite the rosary at 8 p.m. today. (5-22-72)
