Lady Dies Suddenly

Mrs. Wm. Colchin Dies Here Saturday

Funeral services for Mrs. Catherine E. Tawney-Colchin, 64, wife of William P. Colchin and well known Decatur lady, who died suddenly Saturday evening, will be held Wednesday morning at 9 o'clock at the St. Mary's Catholic Church.

Rev. Joseph J. Selmetz will officiate and burial will be made in the Catholic Cemetery. The death came unexpectedly about 6:10 o'clock and was attributed to a heart attack. She had been suffering from influenza.

Surviving besides the husband, are the mother of Muskegon, Michigan; two daughters, Mrs. Anne K. Smith at home and Mrs. Harry Pelle Becker of Louisville, Ky.; a sister, Mrs. Laud Lindquist and four brothers.
