Mrs. Theresa Coyne Is Taken By Death

Mrs. Theresa Helen Coyne, 86, a resident of Decatur for 39 years, died at 6:15 p.m. Saturday at the Adams county memorial hospital after an illness of several years of complications.

She was born in Germany Dec. 5, 1873, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Ferdinand Weinschenk, and came to Adams county from Illinois in 1821. She was married to Henry Coyne in February of 1898.

Mrs. Coyne was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic church, the Third Order of St. Francis and the Rosary society.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Margaret Raudenbush, Mrs. Bernard Rumschlag and Miss Clara Coyne, all of Decatur; three sons, Paul Coyne of Monroeville, Francis Coyne of Decatur, and Leo Coyne of Fremont; 19 grandchildren; two step grandchildren, and 37 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. Tuesday at the St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Gillig & Doan funeral home until time of the services. The Third Order of St. Francis will recite the rosary a 7:30 o'clock this evening and the Holy name society at 8 p.m.
