Kenneth L. DeBolt, 79, of Decatur, died at 7:36 p.m. Sunday in Adams Memorial Hospital.

He was born in Van Wert County, Ohio, on June 24, 1925 to Dora and S. Della Cook DeBolt. He married JoAnn Walker on March 21, 1946; she died on February 1, 2003.

He retired in 1984 from Maloley Brothers in Fort Wayne after 42 years in the meat-cutting business. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and the Korean War. He was a member of American Legion Post 43 in Decatur and a former member of the Fraternal Order of Police.

Surviving are four daughters, Mrs. Deryl (Joy A.) Bauman, Toni J. DeBolt, Mrs. Jon (Danielle L.) Fuhrman, and Mrs. Tobin (Michelle M.) Ray, all of Decatur; two sisters, Lucille G. Secaur and N. LaVon Grice, both of Decatur; and three grandchildren. Two brothers and four sisters are deceased.
