Esther Fullenkamp dies this morning

Mrs. Esther M. Fullenkamp, 79, of 311 North Second street, widow of Frederick J. Fullenkamp, longtime Decatur businessman, died at 12:35 a.m. today at the Decatur Community Care Center. She had been in failing health for several years.

A native of Lima, O., she was born May 25, 1892, a daughter of Timothy and Margaret Durkin-Corbett, and was married to Frederick J. Fullenkamp Oct. 18, 1914. Her husband preceded her in death Aug. 18, 1968. Prior to her marriage, she served as legal secretary to the late Nathan Nelson, Decatur attorney.
