David A. Gage Dies Early This Morning

David A. Gage, 23, lifelong resident of Decatur until a few weeks ago, died suddenly at 1:30 o'clock this morning at the Lutheran hospital in Fort Wayne.

The young man, son of Mr. and Mrs. Gerald A. Gage, 339 North 11th street, became ill Sunday night at his home, 3702 ½ Winter street, fort Wayne, and was taken to the hospital, where he died within a short time.

Born in Decatur March 18, 1942, he was a son of Gerald A. and Mary K. Leonard-Gage, and was married Jan. 3 of this year to Miss Stella Masierak. He was a 1960 graduate of Decatur Catholic high school, and was employed at the Decatur Casting Co.

The young man was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church and the Knights of Columbus.

Surviving in addition to his wife and parents are three brothers, Patrick, Stephen, and Ron Gage, all of Decatur, and one sister, Mrs. Tom (Joan) Gross of Decatur.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9:15 a.m. Thursday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. The body was removed to the Gillig, Doan and Sefton funeral home where friends may call after 7 p.m. Tuesday until time of services. The rosary will be recited at 8 p.m. Wednesday.
