

Mrs. Raymond Gase dies in Tennessee

Mrs. Dorothy F. Gase, 54, wife of Raymond Gase of Humbolt, Tenn., and a former Decatur resident, died at 3:30 a.m. Sunday at the Baptist memorial hospital, Memphis, Tenn., following heart surgery.

She was born in Adams county Sept. 16, 1915, a daughter of Harvey and Clara Topp-LaFontaine, and was married to Raymond Gase in May of 1943.

Mrs. Gase was a member of the Sacred Heart Catholic church at Humbolt, and the Rosary society.

Surviving in addition to the husband are two daughters, Mrs. Thomas (Eileen) Forteney of Humbolt and Miss Susan Gase of Newark, N.J.; two sons, Herbert LaFontaine of Decatur route 6, and Richard LaFontaine of Monroe route 1.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 a.m. Thursday at the St. Mary's Catholic church here, with Rev. Edward Roswog officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery.
