Mary T. Gase, 78, 409 West Adams St., member of a well-known Decatur family, died at 4:30 a.m. today at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where she had been hospitalized one week after an extended illness.

She was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic Church and the Rosary Society.

Born in Adams County on August 4, 1905, she was the daughter of John and Eliabeth Wolpert-Loshe, and married June 4, 1936, to Edward J. Gase; he died December 8, 1975.

Survivors include two children, Donald E. Gase, Warsaw, and Rosemary C. Gase, Decatur, a brother, Herman Loshe, Decatur; two grandchildren; and one great-granddaughter.

One son David J. Gase, died August 28, and one sister and seven brothers also preceded her in death.
