Timothy D. Gase dies this morning

Timothy DeWayne Gase, seven-year old son of Mr. and Mrs. Patrick Gase, 922 Indiana street, died at 5:30 o'clock this morning at the Lutheran hospital in Fort Wayne following an illness of six weeks.

The boy was born in Decatur, July 8, 1959, the son of Patrick and Donna Ladd-Gase, and would have been a second grade student at St. Joseph's Catholic school this fall.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church.
