Lawrence A. Geimer Is Taken By Death

Lawrence A. Geimer, 38, native and lifelong resident of Decatur, died at 2:10 p.m. Sunday at the Veterans hospital at Marion following an illness of seven years.

He was born in Decatur April 25, 1925, a son of Joseph and Bernadine Heideman-Geimer, and attended the local schools. During World War II, he served with the U. S. Coast Guard.

Mr. Geimer was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church and the Holy Name Society.

Surviving are his father, Joseph Geimer of Decatur; one brother, Eugene Geimer of Decatur, and three sisters, Mrs. Florence Koors, Mrs. Lois Rumschlag and Mrs. Mildred Leitz, all of Decatur. His mother and one sister preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9:15 a.m. Tuesday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Gillig & Doan funeral home until time of the services. The Holy Name society will recite the rosary at 7:30 p.m. today.
