BORN IN PENNSYLVANIA

Mr. Gillig was born in B??, Pennsylvania, Oct. 6, 1846, and came to this county in 1882. His wife, Mary Appelman-Gillig, preceded him in death 17 years ago.

Mr. Gillig was one of the oldest and most respected citizens of this city. He was prominently known in the county and because he was ... despite his age he kept constant contact with his friends and ??

He retired from active farming about 14 years ago. He was a member of the St. Mary's Cath (cut off)

Surviving are the following children: William of Chicago, Robert of Fostoria, Ohio, Mrs. Gast and Mrs. Agnes Klosterman, both of Celina; Mrs. Cecelia Sheeter of Bascom, Ohio; Harmon Gillig, local funeral director; Frank Gillig, local factory employe, and ???, also of this city.

Nineteen grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren also survive. He was the last of eight children.

Funeral services will be held Monday morning at 9 o'clock at the St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rev. J. J. Seimetz officiating. Burial will be in the St. Joseph cemetery. The body may be viewed at the Gillig & Doan funeral home after 7 o'clock tonight until time for the funeral.
