Anna K. Ginley Dies This Morning

Miss Anna K. Ginley, 77, of 709 Walnut street, died at 9:20 a.m. this morning at the Adams county memorial hospital following a seven-week illness. She died of complications to several ailments.

The daughter of Tarence and Mary Kain Ginley, she was born July 7, 1884 at Decatur, and live here her entire life. She was never married, and was a retired employee of the Wayne Novelty Co., where she worked many years.

For the past few years she had lived with a sister, Mrs. Rose Green, who survives her. Two brothers and two other sisters are deceased. She was a member of the Rosary Society, St. Vincent De Paul, Catholic Ladies of Columbia, and the third Order of St. Francis.
