Anthony H. Hackman "Tony" Is Taken By Death Funeral Services On Monday

Funeral services will be held here [Decatur, IN] Monday for Anthony H. Hackman, 65, a native of Decatur, who died Thursday afternoon at General hospital in Madison, Wis. of a heart ailment. He had been in ill health for six months and serious for the past six weeks.

He was born in Decatur, IN. March 4, 1884, a son of Bernard and Mary (Spuller) Hackman. He was married to Bertha Miller, who died a few months after their marriage. A painter by trade, he lived in Delavan, Wis. for the past twenty years.

He was a member at St. Andrew's Catholic church in Delavan, a member of the Holy Name society and the Knights of Columbus.

Surviving are a brother, Anselm Hackman, and a sister, Mrs. Anna (Victor) Ulman, both of Decatur, IN. One brother [Albert Hackman] and one sister [Rose Hackman Staub] are deceased.

Funeral services will be held a 9 a.m. Monday at St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rev. Msgr. J.J. Seimentz officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery.
