Death Takes Decatur Man

M.F. Harris, 61, Former Grocer is Dead; Rites Tuesday

Matthew F. Harris, 61, local hardware store employee and former grocer, died of a cerebral hemorrhage Saturday night at his home here.

He was born at Butler and came here in 1915. Surviving are the widow; one son, George Harris of Decatur; two daughters, Mary and Flothilda Harris of Decatur, and three grandchildren. One daughter, Florence Harris, died two months ago. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus.

Funeral services will be held at 9:00 Tuesday morning at the St. Mary's Catholic Church, with Rev. J.J. Seimetz, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery.
