Frances Heimann dies unexpectedly

Mrs. Frances V. Heimann, 71, widow of Jacob Heimann, died suddenly of a heart attack at 2:30 p.m. Tuesday at her home in Decatur route 4.

Born in Paulding county, O., July 4, 1895, she was the daughter of Paul and Mary Geimer-Miller, but had resided in Adams county since early childhood. She was married to Jacob C. Heimann Oct 20, 1915. Her husband preceded her in death Feb. 25, 1963.

Mrs. Heimann was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rosary society, St. Ambrose Study club and St. Anne's Grandmothers club.

Surviving are three sons, Charles, Jerome and Fred Heimann, all of Decatur; seven daughters, Miss Helen Heimann, Mrs. Rita Gerber, Mrs. Walter (Kathleen) Baker, Mrs. Gerald (Irene) Grove, and Mrs. William (Mary) Lichtle, all of Decatur, Mrs. Arthur (Joan) Wilder of Woodburn, and Mrs. Louis (Margaret) Savioe of Monroeville; one sister, Mrs. Gertrude Markley of Fort Wayne; three brothers, Anthony Miller of Kalamazoo, Mich., Leo and Leonard Miller, both of Fort Wayne; and 38 grandchildren. One daughter, Mrs. Justine Miller, three brothers and five sisters are deceased.

Funeral services will be held at 9:30 a.m. Friday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Gillig-Doan & Sefton funeral home after 7 p.m. today until time of the services. The rosary will be recited at 8:15 p.m. Thursday.
