Former local lady dies at Winchester

Mrs. Elizabeth Hendricks, 87, of Winchester, former resident of Adams county, and mother of John Hendricks of Decatur, died at 4 a.m. today at the Randolph county hospital in Winchester.

Mrs. Hendricks, a native of Germany, lived in Adams county from 1885 to 1932, when she moved to Winchester. She operated a fruit market and restaurant in that city for a number of years.

Mrs. Hendricks was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic church at Winchester.

Surviving are five sons, John Hendricks of Decatur, Theodore Hendricks of Thomasville, Ga., Harvey Hendricks of Star Lake, Wis., Jule Hendricks of Eaton, and Walter Hendricks of Greenville, O.; three daughters, Mrs. Roy Lehman of Muncie, Mrs. Arvin Williams of Winchester, and Mrs. George Chenoweth of Charlotte, Mich.; 18 grandchildren, 42 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild. Her husband, Theodore A. Hendricks, is deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Saturday at the St. Joseph's Catholic church at Winchester, with Rev. William Grady officiating. The body will be brought to this city for burial in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Maynard & Walker funeral home at Winchester from 7 to 9 p.m. Thursday and from 3 to 5 and 7 to 9 p.m. Friday. The rosary will be recited at 7:30 p.m. Friday.
