She was born on August 24, 1920 in Adams County to Noah and Leah Luginbill Ellenberger. She married Richard L. Hess on October 18, 1946; he died on July 14, 1979. She married Gilbert Harder on October 30, 1982; he survives.

She was a homemaker and a member of St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic Church and its Rosary Society.
