Alma M. Holthouse dies at Fort Wayne

Mrs. Alma M. Holthouse, 75, of 3916 Barr street, Fort Wayne, and a native and former resident of Decatur, died at 6:15 a.m. Sunday at the Lutheran hospital, where she had been a patient since July. She had been ill for one year.

She had resided in Fort Wayne 35 years and was a member of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, its Rosary society and the Auxiliary of the Legion of Mary.

Mrs. Holthouse was employed 12 years by the Kroger Co. until retiring 10 years ago.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Frances V. Wehrle and Miss Dorothy Holthouse, both of Fort Wayne, and Mrs. Mary G. Taylor of Bishop, Calif.; a son, Clarence F. Holthouse of San Francisco; two sisters, Mrs. William Kline of Syracuse, and Mrs. John Fletter of Rome City; two brothers; Charles Starost of Fort Wayne, and Florian Starost of San Jose, Calif.; eight grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at 8:30 a.m. Wednesday at the Mungovan & Sons mortuary and at 9 a.m. at the Cathedral, with Msgr. Thomas L. Durkin officiating.

Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery in Decatur.
