Antonia Jauregui Dies This Morning

Mrs. Antonia Jauregui, 50, of 845 North 13th street, died at 8:30 o'clock this morning at the Adams county memorial hospital following an illness of several weeks of complications.

She was born in Mexico Nov. 19, 1909, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Ortiz, and was married to Emanuel Jauregui Dec. 26, 1924. She had resided in Decatur for the past 40 years.

Mrs. Jauregui was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic church and the Rosary society.

Surviving in addition to her husband and father are two sons, Salvador and Joseph Jauregui both of Decatur; two daughters, Mrs. Joan Cideron of Racine, Wis., and
