Katherine Kitson dies here Sunday

Mrs. Katherine N. Kitson, 49, of Ohio City, O., route 2, former resident of Decatur, died at 2:15 p.m. Sunday at the Adams county memorial hospital, following an illness of one year.

Her husband, A. William Kitson, died May 16 of this year.

She was born in Van Wert county, O., Feb. 9, 1918, a daughter of John and Princess Hoghe-Brown, and was married to A. William Kitson Sept. 16, 1940.
