Martin L. Lose Dies Early This Morning

Martin Leo Lose, 61, native of Decatur, and brother of two Decatur men, died early this morning at his home at Crooked Lake, near Angola, where he had made his home for the past few years. Death was believed due to a coronary attack.

Mr. Lose had owned and operated the Pioneer Barber Supply, 234 East Columbia St., Fort Wayne, for more than 40 years.

He was born in Decatur Oct. 7, 1899, a son of Mr. and Mrs. John Lose, and was married to Mildred Striebe, also of this city.

Mr. Lose was a member of the St. Anthony Catholic church Angola.

Surviving in addition to his wife are two brothers, Charles and William P Lose, both of Decatur. Three brothers, John, Joseph and Dr. Frank Lose, preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 a.m. Thursday at the St. Anthony Catholic church in Angola, the Rev. Dunstan Bryan officiating. The body will be brought to the Decatur Catholic cemetery for burial, with graveside services at 1:30 p.m. Thursday. Friends may call at the Klink funeral home in Angola after 1 p.m. Wednesday. The rosary will be recited at 8 p.m. Wednesday at the funeral home.
