George Loshe Dies After Long Illness

George F. Loshe, 50, of 104 Jefferson street, and a lifelong resident of Adams county, died at 3:30 o'clock Monday afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital. He had been in failing health for the past year.

He was born in Adams county, Dec. 10, 1909, a son of Mr. and Mrs. John Loshe, and had never married. He was employed at the Decatur General Electric plant for many years until health forced his retirement.

Mr. Loshe was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic church, the Holy Name society and the Loyal Order of Moose.

Surviving are six brothers, Leo Loshe of Coldwater, O., Herbert, Bernard, Herman and Arthur Loshe, all of Decatur, and Albert Loshe of Fort Wayne, and one sister, Mrs. Edward (Mary) Gase of Decatur. One brother and one sister preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday at St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. The body was removed to the Gillig & Doan funeral home, where friends may call after 5 o'clock this evening until time of the services. The rosary will be recited at 8 o'clock this evening.
