### **Kenneth Loshe Dies After Long Illness**

Kenneth R. Loshe, 35, of 521 south 123th street, died at 10:15 this morning at the Parkview memorial hospital in Fort Wayne. He had been ill of complications for an extended length of time, and had been hospitalized for the past seven months.

Mr. Loshe was an employee of the Yost Construction Co.

He was born in Decatur Aug. 30, 1929, a son of Bernard and Frances Meyer-Loshe, and was a lifelong resident of this city.

Mr. Loshe was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Holy Name society and the Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus.

Surviving are his wife, Karyne; one son, Dean Loshe, at home; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Loshe of Decatur; three brothers, Charles Loshe of Flint, Mich., and Joseph and Ronald Loshe, both of Decatur, and two sisters, Mrs. Ed (Rita) Linder and Mrs. Vincent (Joyce) Faurote, both of Decatur.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9:15 a.m. Monday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. The body was removed to the Gillig, Doan & Sefton funeral home, where friends may call after 7 p.m. Saturday until time of the services. The rosary will be recited at 8 p.m. Sunday.
