Margaret Mylott Lyons, 83, a native of Adams County, died at 1:30 p.m. Friday at her Silver Spring, Md. home, where she had resided for a number of years.

A member of a prominent Decatur family, she was born July 26, 1903, the daughter of Martin J. and Mary T. Fullenkamp-Mylott, and was married to Stephen J. Lyons on March 17, 1942; he died Sept. 2, 1984.

She was formerly employed as secretary to W.A. Klepper of the former Cloverleaf Creamery Co. in Decatur, and with the J. W. Thompson Advertising Co. of Chicago, Illinois. Mrs. Lyons was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church and the Rosary Society of Silver Spring, Md.

Survivors include one brother, Frederick "Pete" Mylott of Findlay, O., and a number of relatives in Decatur. Two brothers are deceased.

A Mass of Resurrection will be held at 10 a.m. Monday in St. Mary's Catholic Church, Father Robert Dombrowski officiating. Burial will be in St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery. Friends may call from 2-4 and 7-9 p.m. Sunday at the Sefton Funeral Home. Rosary services will be held there at 8 p.m. Sunday.
