Abbie Meyer, 72, dies this morning

Mrs. Abbie Meyer, 72, prominent Decatur lady, widow of Herman (Hi) Meyer, died suddenly early this morning at her home, 439 North Second street.

She was born in Jay county Jan. 1, 1900, a daughter of Peter and Susan Portz-Uleman, and was married to Herman Meyer Oct. 1, 1917. Her husband, a retired businessman, preceded her in death Dec. 22, 1971.
