

"FRITZ" MILLER DIES AT AUBURN

Francis W. (Fritz) Miller, 48, former Decatur resident, was pronounced dead on arrival at the DeKalb county memorial hospital, Auburn, after being stricken by a heart attack at 6:30 p.m. Friday at his home, Waterloo route 1. He had not been ill.

He was born in Wells County, Aug. 4, 1924, a son of Leonard and Icy Davison-Miller, and was married to Joan J. Colchin, Jan. 17, 1948. The family moved from Decatur to Waterloo 10 years ago.

Mr. Miller was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church at Waterloo, and the Holy Name society. He was a Navy veteran of World War II, and was employed at International Harvester in Fort Wayne.

Surviving are his wife; his parents, who reside in Tocsin; three sons, Dennis Miller of Waterloo, and Christopher and Kevin Miller, at home; one daughter, Mrs. Leroy (Monica) Ordway of Butler; three brothers, Clarence of Bluffton, George of Atlanta, Ga., and Robert H. of Decatur; three sisters, Mrs. Dora (Charlotte) Murray of Poneto, Mrs. Martha Townsend of Mars Hill, Me., and Mrs. Eugene (Doris) Loshe of Decatur and two grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Tuesday at St. Mary's Catholic Church in this city, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery.
