Celia P. Rahrig is taken by death

Mrs. Celia P. Rahrig, 90, a native of Decatur, and widow of Joseph Rahrig, died Sunday morning at the Villa Marie nursing home, Green Springs, O., where she had been a patient for three years.

She was born in Decatur March 30, 1876, a daughter of Joseph and Phoebe Parent, but had resided in Fostoria, O., for many years. Her husband preceded her in death in May, 1956.

Mrs. Rahrig was a member of St. Wendelin's Catholic church and the Rosary society at Fostoria.

Surviving are numerous nieces and nephews, including Mrs. Robert Ulman and Mrs. Ralph Roop of Decatur. Five brothers and two sisters are deceased.
