Rauch Infant Boy Dies This Morning

Brian DeWayne Rauch, three-week-old son of Max and Mary Lou Wendel-Rauch of Decatur route 6, died at 7:30 o'clock this morning at the Riley hospital in Indianapolis, where he had been a patient for three weeks.
