Karl Schnepf Dies Suddenly Saturday

Karl W. Schnepf, 48, of 720 North Third street, well known General Electric Co. employee, died at 1:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital, only a few hours after suffering a cerebral hemorrhage at his home.

Born in Jefferson township, Van Wert county, O., Jan. 19, 1914, he was a son of Benjamin and Sarah E. Barrone-Schnepf, and was married to Mary Gase Dec. 26, 1838. He attended the Wren, O., high school.

Mr. Schnepf, an employee of the G.E. plant here since 1942, also delivered the Sunday Fort Wayne Journal-Gazette on route 4 and 5.

Surviving in addition to his wife are two sons, James Schnepf, with the U.S. Air Force at the Hill Air Force Base in Utah, and Ronald Schnepf, at home; two daughters, Mrs. James (Catherine) McHugh of Decatur, and Miss Patricia Schnepf, at home; and one brother, Clarence Schnepf of Van Wert, O. One brother is deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Zwick funeral home, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home until time of the services
