Sylvester A. Staub dies this morning

Sylvester A. Staub, 90, of 107 North Fifth street, well known retired farmer, died at 12:10 a.m. today at the Adams county memorial hospital following an illness of one week.

He was born in Tiffin, O., Nov. 30, 1875, a son of Gregory and Agnes Bohner-Staub, and had resided in Adams county for many years. He was married to Rosa Hackman in April 1904. His wife preceded him in death Jan. 3, 1946.

Mr. Staub was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the third Order of St. Francis, Knights of Columbus, and the Holy Name society.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Lawrence (Helen) Gase of Decatur; two sons, Bernard Staub of Decatur route 2, and Louis Staub of Decatur route 5, and 12 grandchildren. A son, Frederick, was killed in action during World War II. Two brothers and six sisters are deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt in charge. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Gillig, Doan & Sefton funeral home after 7 p.m. today until time of the services. The third Order of St. Francis will meet at the funeral home at 7:30 p.m. Friday, followed by the Holy Name rosary at 8 p.m.
