

**BERNETA TEEPLE DIES AT HOSPITAL**

Mrs. Berneta (Ann) Teeple, 74, of route 3, Monmouth road, died unexpectedly at 7:20 a.m. this morning at the Adams county memorial hospital where she had been a patient since Tuesday.

The widow of the late David H. Teeple, former co-owner and eldest brother in the Teeple Truck Lines, she was born in Decatur June 12, 1900, the daughter of Joel and Grace Shaw Reynolds. She was a member of the St. Marys Catholic church, the Rosary Society and the Women of the Moose.

She was married to Mr. Teeple June 16, 1919. He preceded her in death Dec. 29, 1965 in Port Richey, Fla.

Survivors include three daughters: Mrs. Robert (Catherine) Spiegel, Sumter, S.C.; Mrs. James B. (Marilyn) Roop, route 3, Mrs. Loren P. (Joyce Ann) Ensign, Sherwood, O.; a son, Donald Pat Teeple, route 3; 23 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

A son, Richard was killed May 28, 1944 in Burma during World War II, and a son Raymond died in infancy. A grandson is also deceased.
