Mrs. Harold Teeter dies at hospital

Mrs. Virginia A. Teeter, 47, wife of Harold Teeter, 633 Trails End, died at 9:05 o'clock Saturday night at the Adams county memorial hospital, where she had been a patient three days. Death followed an extended illness.
