

Former Decatur Woman Died

DECATUR, Ind.. Nov. 24. — Relative here have received the sad message of the death of Mrs. Michael Touhey, which occurred at her home in Lima O., yesterday afternoon following a long illness with heart and liver trouble. For the past two weeks her condition had been serious and her sisters, Mrs. Mary Meyers and Miss Elizabeth Voglewede, and Mrs. Anthony Voglewede, of this city, had been with her during that time and were with her at her death. The deceased was born in this county fifty two years ago, being Miss Catharine Voglewede, daughter of Henry and Mary Voglewede, now deceased. She was married in young womanhood to Michael Touhey and they resided her for several years after their marriage then going to Lima, O.. where he engaged in the railroad business. She leaves the husband and one son John, she is also survived by the following brothers and sisters: Henry, John, Gerrhard, Anthony Voglewede. Mrs. Mary Meyers and Miss Elizabeth Voglewede, of this city, and Louis Voglewede, of Muskogee, Okla.

The remains will be brought to this city tomorrow noon over the Erie and taken to the home of her brother, Henry Voglewede, where the body will be in state until Friday morning, when the funeral will be held at 9 'clock (sun time) from St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rev. Father Wilens officiating.
