Mrs. Vergara dies of heart attack

Mrs. Pascual G. Vergara, 61, of 1027 Krick street, died at 5:30 a.m. this morning at the Adams county memorial hospital of a heart attack. She had suffered from heart trouble for the past year and had been hospitalized since Sunday.

She was born Mary J. Juarez, daughter of Francisco and Pastora Roderiegez Juarez July 12, 1904 in Mexico. She was married Oct. 20, 1922 to Pasqual G. Vergara, who survives. A housewife, she was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church. Her husband is employed by the Norfolk and Western R. R.

Survivors in addition to the husband include: six sons and a daughter in Decatur: Pastor Silvino, Albert Anthony, Trinidad, Ralph and Rosemary; and a second daughter, Mrs. Ben (Antionette) Tarango, Los Angeles, Calif.; and nine grandchildren. One daughter, two brothers and a sister are deceased.
