Edward Vian Dies Suddenly Tuesday

Edward J. Vian, 53, well known lifelong resident of Decatur, died suddenly at 2:30 p.. Tuesday at his home, 940 Dierkes street, shortly after suffering a heart attack while working in the yard at the home.

Although he had been ill for the past year, his death was unexpected. His wife, Mary Ann, died only two weeks ago following a heart attack.

Born in Decatur Feb. 22, 1912, he was the son of Henry and Mary Frances Sether - Vian, and was married to the former Mary Ann Lose April 16, 1937. His wife died May 25, of this year.

Mr. Vian, foreman of the extraction department at the Central Soya Co. plant in this city, was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Knights of Columbus and the Holy Name society.

Surviving are one daughter, Miss Joyce Ann Vian, and one son, Thomas E. Vian, both at home; two sisters, Mrs. Alvera Lose of Decatur, and Mrs. Margaret Barnett of Dearborn, Mich.; two stepsisters, Mrs. Mary Romer of Ft. Recovery, O.; a half sister, Mrs. Betty Shockman of Celina, O. and two half brothers, Robert Vian of Celina, O., and Joseph Vian of Osgood, O.

Friends may call after 7 p.m. today at the Gillig, Doan & Sefton funeral home, and where the rosary will be recited at 87 p.m. Thursday. Funeral services will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. Friday in St. Mary's Catholic church with the Rev. Denis Blank officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery.
