Mrs. Edward Vian Dies This Morning

Mrs. Mary Ann Vian, 52, wife of Edward Vian, and member of a prominent Decatur family, was pronounced dead on arrival at the Adams county memorial hospital about 8 o'clock this morning, after being stricken at her home, 940 Dierkes street.

Although she had been in ill health for the past three years, her death was unexpected.

Born in Decatur Jan. 26, 1913, she was a daughter of William P. and Ida Bogner-Lose, and had resided in Decatur her entire lifetime. She was married to Edward Vian April 16, 1937.

Mrs. Vian was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Catholic Ladies of Columbia, and the Rosary society.

Surviving in addition to her husband are one daughter, Miss Joyce Ann Vian, and one son, Thomas B. Vian, both at home; her father, William P. Lose of Decatur, and one sister, Mrs. Richard (Margaret) Walter of Decatur. Her mother preceded her in death in September of 1964.

Friends may call at the Gillig, Doan & Sefton funeral home after 7 p.m. Wednesday. The rosary will be recited at 8 p.m. Thursday. Funeral services will be conducted at 9:15 a.m. Friday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt in charge. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery.
