Adeline Wagner dies at hospital

Mrs. Adeline M. Wagner, 76, 405 West Adams street, died at 3:30 p.m. Friday at the Adams county memorial hospital, where she had been a patient since fracturing her hip in a fall three weeks ago. She apparently was recovering when stricken by a heart ailment.

Born in Decatur Jan. 25, 1890, she was a daughter of Peter and Catherine Weber-Schneider, and resided in Michigan for a number of years before returning to Decatur.

Mrs. Wagner was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rosary society, Catholic Ladies of Columbia, and the St. Vincent de Paul society.

Surviving are three sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth Walmsley and Mrs. Merrill (Frances) Peterson, both of Decatur, and Mrs. Carl Phelps of Saginaw Mich.; and five brothers, Otto, Norbert and Aloysius Schnieder, all of Decatur, Edgar Schneider of Pontiac, Mich., and Joseph Schneider of New Jersey.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9 a.m. Monday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. Friends may call at the Gillig, Doan & Sefton funeral home after 7 p.m. today until time of the services. The rosary will be recited at 7:30 p.m. Sunday.
