CHARLENE WHITE, 39, MOTHER OF SIX, DIES

Mrs. Charlene H. White, Decatur, route 6, mother of six children, died Friday at 1:45 p.m. at the Parkview Memorial Hospital in Fort Wayne, where she had been admitted two days earlier.

She was born Aug. 12, 1933 in Washington Township, the daughter of Arthur B. and Helen Tricker-Wilder and was married on April 16, 1955 to William White, Jr.

Mrs. White is survived by her mother, who resides at Decatur, route 4, and her husband. Other survivors include six children, William Arthur, Renee Marie, Donna Jean, Paula Rose, Joseph Glenn, and Carol Ann, all at home; four sisters, Mrs. Harold J.
