DOUBLE FUNERAL OF MR. AND MRS. KUKELHAN

DECATUR, Ind. Nov. 12 - More than a thousand persons attended the funeral of Mr. and Mrs. Frederick Kukelhan, the aged couple who were killed Saturday evening at Maples by a Pennsylvania railroad train while driving to New Haven to visit with relatives. The funeral was held this afternoon at the Fuelling German Lutheran church seven miles north of this city, the Rev. Klansing preaching in English and Rev. Dornseif in German.

It was a most sad affair, the two aged companions - he sixty-four years of age and she fifty-nine years - lying side by side on the bier surrounded by their six children - five boys and one girl - so suddenly and cruelly deprived of both parents' care. Three children have preceded them in death.

They were buried side by side in one grave in the church cemetery.
