Mrs. Schieferstein died at 8:31 a.m. Thursday in the emergency room of the Adams County Memorial Hospital after suffering a heart attack at her home a short time earlier.

Her son, Dean, died at 8 p.m. Thursday at the Lutheran Hospital, Fort Wayne, where he had been a patient since Monday. He had been in ill health for more than six months.

Dean A. Schieferstein, a Root Township farmer, was a member of the St. Peter's Lutheran Church and American Legion Post 43.

Born in Decatur on Feb. 27, 1946, he was the son of Thurman D. (T.D.) and Helen H. Bohnke-Schieferstein. His father resides at 816 Parkview Drive.

Survivors also include a sister, Mrs. Dale (Karen) Uhrick, Decatur; and two brothers, Phillip D. Rt. 3, Decatur and Don D., Decatur.
