ALBERT CARTER DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Albert Wellington Carter, 41, died at 5:40 a.m. today at his home on West Lincoln Highway. He had been in failing health for four years and his death was attributed to multiple sclerosis.

Mr. Carter was born October 13, 1910, at Missouri Valley, Iowa, the son of Sanford and Noma (McBarnes) Carter. He was graduated from Wren High School with the class of 1931.

At the time he became ill, he was employed at the Lima Locomotive Works. He was a member of the Eagles Lodge at Rockford.

Surviving with his parents, with whom he resided, are a brother, Raymond of Brownsboro, Texas, and a sister, Mrs. Oliver Chester of Fort Wayne, Ind.

Funeral services in charge of the Cowan and Son Funeral Home will be conducted at 2:30 p.m. Monday at the Wren EUB Church, Rev. H. L. Smith of Willshire to officiate. Burial will be in Mt. Tabor cemetery in Adams County, Ind. The body will be returned to the family home at 2 p.m. Sunday.
