WILL HOLD AUTOPSY ON URVIN CARTER

DECATUR, Ind. Aug. 28 - Urvin Carter, aged sixty-seven, is dead at his home at Pleasant Mills after a long illness from asthma and other complications that baffled the skill of physicians. An autopsy will be conducted by Dr. Vizard to determine the exact cause of death. The deceased was for many years a farmer of St. Mary's township, but seven years ago moved to Pleasant Mills, where he led a retired life. He leaves a widow and five children - Mrs. Hurless of Wren; William, Calvin, Sanford and Elizabeth. The funeral will be held Monday morning at 10 o'clock from the Baptist church in Pleasant Mills by the Rev. James Sprague.
