Mrs. Sarah Cowan, Widow of Ezra Cowan, Died Last Night

At Home of Son

Body Will Be Brought Here Tomorrow - Funeral Saturday

Word was received here today of the death of Mrs. Sarah Death Cowan, aged 70 years, widow of Ezra Cowan, long a prominent resident of St. Marys township. The death of this esteemed lady occurred last evening at the home of a son, Kit Cowan, at Lima, O., and followed a long illness. Yesterday her daughter, Mrs. Jesse Steele, of Pleasant Mills, who had been at her bed side at various times during her illness, received word that her condition was worse and she and her husband left yesterday for Lima, to be with her. The body will be brought here tomorrow afternoon over the Chicago & Erie and will be taken to the home of J. L. Gay on North Second street until Saturday when the funeral will be held Saturday morning at ten o'clock from the Methodist church at Rivarre, with the Rev. Conway in charge. Burial will be in Mt. Tabor.

The death of Mr. Cowan took place May 1, 1909.

MRS. SARAH M. COWAN DIES AT SON'S HOME

Mrs. Sarah M. Cowan, age 68 years, died at the home of her son, Kit C. Cowan, 622 S. Pine St. Thursday of General debility, after an illness of 2 weeks.

Since the death of her husband, Mrs. Cowan has been making her home with her son and daughter, Mrs. J. H. Steele of Pleasant Mills, Ind. She came here to spend the winter with her son, when her death took place. The body was accompanied to Decatur, Ind. today where funeral services will be held Saturday at 10:00 from the Bobo Methodist Church, 6 miles east of Decatur. Rev. Conway assisted by Rev. Elston of that place will have charge of the services. Burial at Mt. Tabor Cemtery.
