

ELISHA GAUSE DIES SUDDENLY SATURDAY

Funeral Services Tuesday Afternoon

Elisha Gause, 41, employee of the Krick-Tyndall Tile Co. in this city, who resided one and one-half miles west of Salem, died suddenly at noon Saturday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, a short time after suffering a heart attack at his home.

He was born in Decatur Jan 15, 1913, a son of Homer and Nellie Emerson-Gause, and was married to Gertrude Womack April 7, 1934.

The family had moved from Decatur only a few months ago. Mr. Gause was employed as a welder at the tile mill and formerly worked at the General Electric and Decatur Casting Co.
