DECATUR, Ind. - Nov 27 Funeral services for Curtis Heath, second influenza-pneumonia at Bobo within five days, will be Thursday, with an open air service at Mount Tabor Cemetery. His death occurred yesterday. The first influenza death in the vicinity was that of Emmett Death, son of Clifford Death, last Friday. Curtis Heath was a son of Mrs. Lavina Heath and the late William Heath. A sister, Bertha; a brother, Dorse and an uncle, Ephraim Heath, all at the same home, are also ill, but are better. Are surviving relatives are a brother, Heber, a soldier stationed at Indianapolis and a sister, Ada Heath, at Barberton, O. In the Clifford Death family, five members ill are recovering, while a sixth, Miss Eva Death, of the Madison house, this city, who went home for her brother's funeral, is a new victim.
