

DIES IN FAR EAST

**Adams County Lady Dies In Colorado -
Had Gone There For Her Health**

DECATUR, Ind. Nov 18 - Messrs. Harvey and Wilson Lee, of this city, today received a telegraph message stating that their sister, Mrs. Setta Love, wife of C. H. Love, of Geneva, had died this morning at 9 o'clock in Florence, Col., from consumption. About a year ago, Mrs. Love, accompanied her two children and her sister, Miss Effie Lee, went to Colorado, hoping that the climate might prove beneficial to her health. Though her condition was known to be quite serious, her death comes as a great shock to her many friends here.

The deceased was about thirty-eight years of age and was well-known in this county, where she lived all her life. Prior to going west she made her home with her husband in Geneva. Her husband and two children - a girl aged seven and a boy about five years old - survive. She also leaves two brothers - Harvey and Wilson Lee, of this city - and two sisters, Mrs. William Ayres of Pleasant Mills and Miss Effie, now in Colorado. It is quite probable that the body will be brought here, though definite arrangements have not yet been made.
