

Samuel Teeple Passes Monday
Retired Builder Had Part in 1893 Fair

Samuel W. Teeple, 74, died at 4:15 o'clock Monday morning at his home at 318 Field street, following an extended illness.

A carpenter by trade, he was superintendent of construction of the mines and mining building at the 1893 World fair at Chicago. He was building superintendent of the Citizens Trust company building for 20 years, retiring January 1, 1929.

Mr. Teeple was an active worker at First M. E. church, of which he was a member. He was a member of the official church board, and was interested in mission work.

Survivors include the widow, Annie; three sons, Lawrence K. of Portland, Ore.; Ralph J. of Atlanta, Ga., and John H. Teeple of this city; four grandchildren; a half-brother, Orin Teeple of this city, and two half-sisters, Mrs. Lou Buchanan of Los Angeles, Cal., and Mrs. Bertha Korporal of this city.

The body was removed to Chalfant & Cutshall's funeral home, and will be returned to the residence Tuesday afternoon.
