

LOREN TROUTNER DIES AT MUNCIE

Loren B. Troutner, 49, a native of Adams county, and a teacher in the Gaston school, died Sunday at Ball memorial hospital in Muncie.

A son of Charles and Mary Troutner, he was born in Adams county May 27, 1916. He was a graduate of Ball State University and had resided in Muncie for 15 years. Mr. Troutner was a member of the Walnut St. Baptist church at Muncie.
