Mrs. Mary Troutner Is Taken By Death Funeral Services Tuesday Afternoon

Mrs. Mary Troutner, 76, of 614 West Adams street, died at 12:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital following an illness of two years. She was born in Adams county May 7, 1881, and was a lifelong resident of the county. Her husband, Charles Troutner, died a number of years ago.

Mrs. Troutner was a former member of the Pleasant Mills Baptist church.

Surviving are four sons, the Rev. Harry L. Troutner of Bellevue, O., Clyde O. Troutner of Fort Wayne, Hobart Troutner of Decatur, and Loren B. Troutner of Muncie; one daughter, Miss Verle L. Troutner of Richmond; a brother, Willis Brewer, of Flint, Mich.; four half-brothers, Floyd, Lester, Kenneth and Arthur Brewer, all of West Branch, Mich., and two half-sisters, Mrs. Ted Myers of Kenton, O., and Mrs. Hazel Priddy of West Branch, Mich. Three sons and one daughter preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Black funeral home and at 2 p.m. at the Union Chapel Evangelical United Brethren church, the Rev. Harry L. Troutner and the Rev.
